Overview of the plans

- Part of an administrative arrangement between JRC and DG CLIMA; supported by external experts
 - Roundtable discussions with the Member States
 - Country visits for bilateral/multilateral assistance

Will run in parallel with a project managed by the EEA



Objectives

- Improved inventories
 - Compliance with Reg. 2018/841 and 2018/1999
 - Better understanding of needs to improve monitoring under enhanced climate targets
- Enhanced collaboration and co-learning between the Member States
 - Identification of common issues between different MS LULUCF inventories
 - Roundtable meetings to help to know each other, and to discuss problems and their solutions



Planned set-up of the project

- Roundtable discussions
 - Thematic sub-groups based on relevance of the topic, geographical region, data availability etc.
- Bilateral assistance to selected MS on specific topics

JRC workshops in 20-21 June 2022 and in June 2023



Possible topics

- Reporting of dead wood
- Key pools in key categories to be reported with at least Tier 2
- Land use conversions to be reported using geographically-explicit data
- Issues identified by the Member States
