General

■ Objectives of the project

- Provide technical assistance and capacity building support to EU MS during the preparation of 2013 and 2014 GHG inventory submissions
- Focus will be laid on ten MS in 2013 and ten MS in 2014
 - The contract was changed recently in order to support 13 MS in 2013 and 7 MS in 2014
- Limited ad-hoc support should be provided to 17 MS
- Duration of the project: 2 years
- Note: the project does not cover support in implementing 2006 IPCC Guidelines

- Country visits

Resources

- Resources are limited
- About 30 country visits for 2013 *and* 2014
- About 170 days for sector experts for 2013 *and* 2014
 - Includes both country visits and support via wiki
- 2013 on average:
 - Experts will have about 8 days per country (for preparation of action plans, support via the wiki discussion forum and country visit)
 - 1.5 visits per country (duration of two days)
 - For LULUCF our experts will have about 5 days per MS in case of a country visit; this includes preparation of action plans and country visit
- Do not expect long country visits or several country visits

Selection process for 2013

- Project team's analysis
 - Statistical analysis: number of findings; year of finding; type of issue
 - Expert judgement/JRC: Focus on latest ARR, ESD, SP, Initial checks
- MS requests
 - Requests received from 14 MS; one MS confirmed on enquiry
- Mapping between project team's analysis and MS request
- Selection criteria
 - Importance of issues raised; priority for LULUCF
 - Importance for the EU inventory
 - EU submission under KP: EU-15 (including KP LULUCF)
 - EU submission under Convention: EU-27

Milestones

- Kick-off: December 2012
- 2013 support:
 - Identification of MS for 2013 support: December 2012
 - Development of action plans: January/February 2013
 - Key support to 13 MS: March/April 2013
 - Ad-hoc support to other MS: February-April 2013
 - Workshop: April/June 2013
- 2014 support:
 - Identification of MS for 2014 support: September 2013
 - Development of action plans: October/November 2013
 - Key support to seven MS: December 2013-April 2014
 - Ad-hoc support to other MS: November 2013-April 2014
- Selection of MS will be done individually for 2013 and 2014

Activities 2013

- Develop action plans (January-February 2013)
 - Includes description of problem/support needed, the type of support (country visit, exchange of experience in the discussion forum (wiki), workshop), a time table for the support provided (e.g. a time table for country visit) and the names of the responsible persons.
 - Project sector experts will develop the action plan in consultation with MS sector experts.
 - Project sector experts are contacting MS sector experts.
 - Action plans should be finalized by end of February
- Exchange of experience in the wiki forum (February – April 2013)
- Country visits (March/April 2013)

Wiki discussion forum (1)

■ Purpose

- All MS to post questions and issues
- Experts (project team *and* MS) to post useful solutions to questions and issues
- Project team and MS experts to post relevant material (e.g. workshop presentations, background material, etc)
- MS experts to consult the wiki if it includes solutions for problems they face

Wiki discussion forum (2)

■ Access to the forum

- Need a wiki account (which is free)
- Password was circulated by the COM to the national contact point
- All MS have access to the forum
 - MS sector experts should have access
 - Participants should identify themselves in order to make discussion transparent
 - Project team will follow-up with “unknown persons”
- Large part of the support for the ten MS should be made via the wiki
 - If confidential issue exchange information by e-mail
- Ad-hoc requests from other 17 MS should be posted in wiki discussion forum
 - If confidential issue contact Justin Goodwin by e-mail

Wiki discussion forum (3)

■ Using the forum

- Forum contains separate sections following the IPCC categories
- Any member can start new thread in the respective category
- Any member can reply to posts within a thread
- Titles should include key words and CRF codes e.g. 1.A.1.a in order to support the search functions
- All MS sector experts are invited to follow and contribute to the discussions
- Guidance section: includes additional technical guidance to address specific issues
- Private messaging: it is possible to send private messages to every user of the forum
- Uploading/downloading files: this is a depository for files relating to this site
- Search function
- Notifications: you will be informed if there are new posts for specific pages
