

- This year, we are beginning with a **series of workshops** to support Member States and facilitate the compliance process, including the use of flexibilities






## **Evaluation of the LULUCF Regulation**


- No (formal) evaluation since adoption in 2018
- Half-way through, preliminary lessons learned from NECP, CAP strategic plans, additional national measures
- Evaluation criteria (from Better Regulation Guidelines):
  - Effectiveness
  - Efficiency
  - Relevance, coherence and added-value
- Results to inform reflections on 2040 EU climate framework
